2. To worship God in a worthy manner through thoughtful words, fervent prayers, and excellent music

3. To provide practical helps that will equip every member in coming into the Image and Likeness of Jesus Christ

(The Acts 2:42–47; Romans 15:14; 1Corinthians 12:12–31; Galatians 5:13, 6:2; Ephesians 4:11–16; 1John 1:3–7).

4. To supply competent pastoral care for each member of the Church family (**The Acts 20:28–31; 1Peter 5:1–4**).

5. To provide an effective Christian education program to inform, train, and disciple all segments of our congregation (Deuteronomy 6:1–9; Psalm 119:9; Proverbs 22:6).

6. To advance the missionary work of the Church in the Gulf Coast area and throughout the world
